Continue to Stechelberg to take the cable car to Murren. Enjoy free time or take the cable car up to the Schilthorn, a revolving restaurant at the "top of the world".

Day 7 Staubbachbankeli (BD)

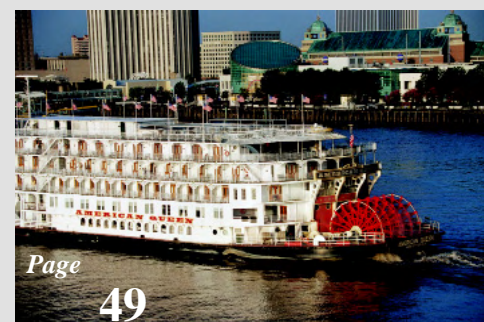
