Day 1 Fly to San Diego (D) Today arrive in sunny San Diego. Meet your Tour Manager and transfer to your hotel for an overnight stay. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner tonight in Old Town San Diego.

Day 2 San Diego/Cruise (BD)

After breakfast, enjoy a San Diego City Tour with a local guide. See the historic Gaslamp District, Downtown, the bustling Embarcadero, Balboa Park and historic Old Town San Diego. Later, board your ship, the *ms Koningsdam*, for your cruise to the Mexican Riviera & Sea of Cortez.

Days 3 & 4 At Sea (2B,2L,2D)

If complete bliss is the destination, *Koningsdam* cruise ship is the journey. Fluid lines, light-filled spaces, and a blend of 21st century elegance and nautical tradition dazzles at every turn. The ship abounds with innovative dining and entertainment options. Head to B.B. King's Blues Club for Memphis R&B, take in visually stunning entertainment at World Stage, or revisit classic hits at Billboard Onboard. There's much to see and do on *Koningsdam*, the first of the cruise ships in Holland America Line's Pinnacle class.

Day 5 Manzanillo (10AM-6PM)

Manzanillo is one of Mexico's busiest, most important ports (some say the busiest and most important). Located on the Pacific, it's nicknamed the Sailfish Capital of the World. It's little wonder, then, that most of the activities in Manzanillo are centered on or near the water, and most of the city's culinary specialties are inspired by the fruits of the sea.

Day 6 Puerto Vallarta (8AM-5PM) (BLD)

The cobblestoned center of town features the ornate Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe church, boutique shops, and a range of restaurants and bars. El Malecón is a beachside promenade with contemporary sculptures, as well as bars, lounges and nightclubs. Day 7 Mazatlán (8AM-5PM)(BLD) Mazatlán is a resort town on the Pacific. Sandy beaches line its 21km-long malecón (boardwalk), and it's known for big-game fishing. In the Centro Histórico, or Old Mazatlán, 19th-c. landmarks include the performance hall Teatro Ángela Peralta and the towering Immaculate Conception basilica.

Day 8 At Sea (BLD) Enjoy your Pinnacle class ship today at

your leisure.

Day 9 Loreto (8AM-10PM) (BLD) Loreto is a city on the Gulf of California. Its colonial buildings include the Misión de Nuestra Señora de Loreto, a 17th-c. church. Off the coast, the islands and waters of Bahía de Loreto National Park are home to dolphins, whales, and pelicans. The city is backed by Sierra de la Giganta mountain range, where trails lead to prehistoric cave paintings.

Day 10 La Paz (8AM-5PM) (BLD)

La Paz is known for its seafront Malecón promenade with beaches, parks and art by Mexican and international artists. Many bars and restaurants overlook the water. In the city center, the 19thc. Nuestra Señora de La Paz Cathedral dominates the shady Velasco Garden. The Whale Museum has displays on the area's gray whales.

Day 11 Cabo San Lucas (7AM-1PM) (BLD)

Cabo San Lucas, a resort city on the tip of Mexico's Baja California peninsula, is known for its beaches. Playa El Médano is Cabo's main beach, with outdoor restaurants and bars. Past the marina is Land's End promontory, site of Playa del Amor (Lover's Beach) and El Arco, a natural archway in the seacliffs.

Days 12& 13 AtSea/Home (2BLD)

Once more you get to enjoy your ship's amenities before your departure tomorrow. On Day 13, disembark and travel home.

Day 1 Arrive in Montreal

Upon arrival in Montreal meet your Tour Manager and transfer to your hotel for a two-night stay in Montreal.

Day 2 Montreal (BD)

With its dual English and French cultures, Montreal is Canada's most cosmopolitan city. See the Plains of Abraham, The Citadel and St. Lawrence River views. Lights, decorations, and snow create an enchanting setting. No wonder CNN ranked Québec City among the world's top 15 destinations for celebrating the Holidays! Visit the German Christmas Market in the heart of Old Québec, a market designed to recreate the atmosphere of the big European Christmas Markets. Visit the illuminated & decorated streets of the Quartier Petit Champlain under the Château Frontenac. Particularly magical in winter, the pedestrian streets are lined with shops and bistros offering a festive atmosphere during the holiday season. This evening enjoy a Farewell Dinner with your fellow travelers at local restaurant with holiday flair.

Day 5 Return Home (B) Transfer to the airport and fly home.

Day 1 Fly to Charleston

Today depart on your flight bound for the South. Spend your first two nights in Charleston, SC, originally founded as Charles Towne in 1670.

Day 2 Middleton Place/ Charleston (BD)

Visit Middleton Place, home to America's oldest landscaped garden. It began in 1741 and took 10 years to complete the terraces, lakes, and camellia alleys. Tour the home and stable yard with its craft displays. This afternoon, enjoy a Charleston City Tour. Both preservation and southern gentility are a way of life here. See the Historic District, Citadel, and Battery Park. Tonight, enjoy a Welcome Dinner with your fellow travelers at a popular local restaurant in Charleston. After dinner enjoy a Holiday Lights Drive through one of Charleston's popular districts decked out for the holiday season.

Day 3 Beaufort/ To Savannah

Visit the Edmonston-Alston House. Despite the ravages of the Civil War, the Earthquake of 1886 and numerous hurricanes, the Alston family pieces remain in place much as they have for over 150 years. Notable in the collection is an original print of the Ordinance of Secession. Then, depart for the historic port city of Beaufort, a quaint 1711 town with narrow treelined streets and historic homes. Enjoy a charming Carriage Ride through town. Next, arrive in Savannah, one of the South's most graceful cities for a two-night stay in the historic district.

Day 4 Savannah (BD) Begin the day with a morning Savannah City Tour. See the 20 original squares, all landscaped with oaks, azaleas, fountains, and statues. Drive by the Old Cotton Exchange, River Street, and Madison Square of General Sherman's 'March to the Sea' fame. Tour the restored Mercer-Williams House Museum prior to a free afternoon. See the sights of John Berendt's *Midnight in the Garden of Good & Evil* or stroll the cobblestone streets at your leisure. Tonight, enjoy southern cuisine at a fine local restaurant. After dinner enjoy some of the wonderful holiday decorations and lights Savannah has to offer.

Day 5 To Jekyll Island (BL)

Motor south today to the Golden Isles of Georgia. Visit St. Simon's Island to view famous Christ Church and the lighthouse. This afternoon, arrive on Jekyll Island, a former hunting reserve for America's top millionaires. Goodyear, Pulitzer. and Rockefeller all built elaborate "cottages" here. Stay at the 1886 Jekyll Island Club, a Victorian-style hotel originally an exclusive retreat for the wealthy. Jekyll Island becomes Holly Jolly Jekyll during the holiday season with over 500,000 light bulbs and 35,000 lights on the Great Tree.

Day 6 Jekyll Island (BD)

This morning enjoy a guided Trolley Tour of the historic district which includes entry into Indian Mound Cottage, the Mosaic Gallery, and Faith Chapel. Your afternoon is at leisure. Tonight's Farewell Dinner is in the Jekyll Island Club's Grand Dining Room, a venue of both social and historical significance which has welcomed guests for over a century.

Day 7 Fly Home (B) Depart for the Jacksonville Airport and your return flight home.




