ARRIVAL FORMS AND TRAVEL SAFETY REQUIREMENTS AFC requires all travelers to complete a Passenger Wellness Certification Form & Waiver of Liability Form before their tour (both forms per passenger). These forms are included with your passenger documents. Please hand these signed & completed forms to your Tour Manager at the arrival airport. If you are making your own way to the first hotel, these signed & completed forms must be given to your Tour Manager before boarding the motorcoach. As the landscape changes, the requirements to travel change. Our Travel Safety Requirements are updated based on the requirements of the destination and our company policies to promote safe travel.



USE OF FACE MASKS OR FACE COVERINGS Face masks/face coverings will be required during many tour experiences including the motorcoach and air travel. AFC will have face masks/face coverings available for guests. We understand that many guests will have their own preferred face coverings.

HOMETOWN TRANSFER VEHICLES

Your ride to and from the airport will feature surfaces that have been disinfected daily and cleaned more frequently than in the past.

FLIGHTS

Airlines have greatly increased and enhanced cleaning & disinfection protocols. Face masks/face coverings are required on board flights and at airports along with preflight health screenings during check in. Details can vary by airline. Visit your airline's website for more details & information.

TOUR MANAGERS

We have enhanced our training for Tour Managers. They are tour management experts and highly trained to handle a variety of unexpected situations on tour — including illnesses and emergencies.

	MOTORCOACHES	Motorcoaches undergo more frequent cleaning and disinfection than in the past. We will still operate with a daily seat rotation, however, if a guest(s) wishes to opt out of the seat rotation, we are happy to assign a seat towards the rear of the coach for the duration of the tour.
24/1	24/7 SUPPORT	In addition to your Tour Manager & Driver, behind the scenes our operations and guest support teams will be in contact with the Tour Manager and on- call 24/7. With our Travel Protection Plan, you'll have access to on- call services should you need it, plus you're covered on tour for emergency assistance, baggage loss, trip interruption, medical expenses and more.
	HOTELS	The American Hotel & Lodging Association (AHLA) introduced guidelines for Safe Stay, an industry-wide enhanced standard of health and safety protocols. Guidelines & protocols will still vary a bit based on region, state, destination & hotel. Generally, rooms and areas such as restaurants, bars and fitness centers will be cleaned regularly with rooms disinfected more frequently. High-traffic areas like lobbies and elevators will be cleaned more frequently. In some cases amenities and services maybe limited.
	TOUR EXPERIENCES	We are selective and are working closely with our local partners to ensure health guidelines are in place during meals, experiences, activities and sightseeing.
	GUEST ASSISTANCE & SELF-SCREENING	AFC is taking measures to make your travel experience enjoyable and safe. We ask all of our guests to do their part as well. Vaccination is highly recommended & required in some destinations. Guests are encouraged to follow CDC recommendations for prevention. CDC recommendations include but are not limited to the use of face masks/face coverings, washing hands frequently with soap and water. The use of hand sanitizer is encouraged as well. We will ask all travelers to monitor their health throughout their tour, with protocols in place in the event someone becomes ill.
